



POLICIES AND RULES FOR PLAY

1. All golfers must check in with the golf shop prior to beginning play on the day's designated starting hole.
2. No play is allowed on any golf course or portion thereof which has been closed for any reason.
3. In order to maintain the Golf Course in first-class fashion, Golfers are required to play the golf course in consecutive hole rotation as assigned, please no exceptions. Golfers who "hole-hop" may be subject to disciplinary action and potential loss of playing privileges.
4. **Golfers are required to fill their divots with the sand mix provided.**
5. Non-playing guests or spectators must be approved in advance by the Head Golf Professional (Golfers requiring special assistance or parents accompanying a child should be pre-approved)
6. Each player must have a set of clubs and bags. Sharing equipment is prohibited.
7. **No practicing or use of more than one ball is allowed on the course, please no exceptions. Poppy Ridge plays host to approximately 60,000 rounds per year, and the "one-ball" rule on the Golf Course is paramount to quality of golfing experience for both NCGA members and guests.**
8. Groups of more than four persons are not allowed on the course, no exceptions please.
9. **Golfers must have a valid driver's license available at the time of renting a golf cart. All drivers must drive safely and responsibly. There is a maximum of 2 carts allowed per tee time. Individuals will be asked to pair up in golf carts, no exceptions please.**
10. All golf carts must follow any local or special circumstance rules designated by the Golf Shop Staff and be returned at least 15 minutes before sunset.
11. Pull carts and golf bags must be left off greens and collars at all times.
12. Unauthorized golf instruction on the course is strictly prohibited.
13. Personal coolers, glass containers and bottles are not allowed on the course at any time. Outside Food and Beverage articles are prohibited at Poppy Ridge Golf Course. Golfers in violation of this policy will be asked to leave the course, and potentially lose their future playing privileges.
14. Animals and pets are not allowed on the course or in the clubhouse at any time. (Service animals may be allowed with pre-approval from the Management team)
15. Golfers may be refused or revoked of playing privileges or may be removed from the course for:
 - A. Submitting false information for the purpose of securing golfing privileges or discounts.
 - B. Playing without paying a green fee or for not registering with the golf shop.
 - C. Failure to comply with existing rules and regulations.
 - D. Intentionally hitting balls off the course into areas or private property adjacent to the course.
 - E. Flagrant violation of rules of etiquette, such as obnoxious behavior, inebriation, intoxication, damaging of courses or failure to follow course design on a hole-to-hole basis.
